*C*ruising west on Albemarle Sound towards Edenton, you will pass under the fixed Albemarle Sound/Highway 32 Bridge, clearance 65 feet. Overhead power lines have a 90-foot minimum vertical clearance in marked channel, and a 70-foot minimum clearance between all the other towers. Once past the power lines watch for entrance marker "2". The channel to Edenton is well-marked, with adequate depths.



*T*he new breakwater protects Edenton town docks from the chop that can develop from a southerly breeze. The entrance to this protected area is to the west side of the breakwater. Visiting boaters may enjoy the charming shops and restaurants within walking distance in this historic town that was once the capital of North Carolina.



*A*ttactions include the Historic Edenton State Historic Site Visitor Center, Chowan County Arts Council and Gallery's exhibit of area photographs, "A Century of Chowan," The Barker House on Edenton Bay and the Edenton National Fish Hatchery featuring fresh water aquariums and exhibits.
